1. Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on 10/08/2022, between Mahila P.G. College, Bahraich, hereinafter referred to as "*the College*", and the District Taekwondo Association, Bahraich, hereinafter referred to as "*the Association*."

Both institutions, recognizing the importance of sports, physical education, and self-defence training in holistic student development, especially among women, have agreed to collaborate for promoting martial arts, fitness, discipline, and empowerment through Taekwondo training and related activities.

2. Purpose of the MoU

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a cooperative framework between the College and the Association to:

- Promote Taekwondo as a means of physical fitness, self-defence, and confidence building among female students.
- Organize training camps, workshops, and demonstrations in the college campus.
- Encourage participation in district, state, and national-level Taekwondo competitions.
- Develop awareness of sports ethics, teamwork, and leadership through martial arts.

3. Scope of Collaboration

This collaboration shall include, but not be limited to, the following areas:

1. Self-Defence Workshops: Regular training sessions and workshops on self-defence techniques for students.
2. Skill Development: Coaching camps to prepare students for participation in Taekwondo competitions.
3. Fitness & Discipline Programmes: Conducting sessions focusing on strength, endurance, and mental discipline.
4. Joint Events: Organizing inter-collegiate or district-level Taekwondo events and exhibitions.
5. Certification: Providing participation or achievement certificates to students completing training programmes.

4. Implementation and Coordination

For the smooth coordination and effective implementation of this MoU, both institutions appoint their respective heads as official representatives responsible for communication and follow-up activities:

5. Financial Arrangements

Both parties agree to utilize their existing infrastructure, sports facilities, and staff for the execution of collaborative activities. No additional financial liabilities shall be incurred by either institution. The trainers and coordinators involved shall not be entitled to any honorarium or additional remuneration under this MoU.

6. Duration and Renewal

This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of signing. Upon completion of this period, it shall automatically renew for successive terms of five (5) years each, unless either party provides written notice of intent to modify or terminate the agreement at least 60 days before the end of the current term.

7. Confidentiality

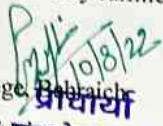
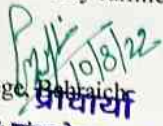
 

Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality regarding all student data, financial information, and institutional communications shared under this MoU, in accordance with applicable laws and institutional policies.

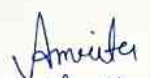
